PROPER FITTING **PROCEDURE**



EASY STEPS

SLIDE HOOF INTO THE OPEN BOOT

CHECK THE POSITION OF THE HOOF

Tap the hoof on the ground as the horse steps down into the boot. Check to see that the hoof is all the way to the front of the boot.



- Start with a clean hoof and boot.
- Open the boot wide.
- Lift up the hoof.
- Slide the clean hoof into the boot toe first.

Quick Check List

- □ Are you slowly introducing your horse to the boots over a few 20 minute sessions?
- Are the hooves and boots clean?
- ☐ Is the hoof seated down into the bottom of the boot?
- ☐ Is the toe to the front of the boot?
- The hoof is centered inside the boot?

FASTEN THE BOOT CLOSED

on either side between the hoof wall and boot wall.



- Affix the wire on the inside of the boot to your choice of setting.
- Close the clip on the outside so that the front flap is snug onto the hoof wall.

* Open the sides of the boot to check that there is not more than a 1/2 cm or 3/16" space

Slide your finger down the back of the boot between the air chamber and your horse's bulbs. It should feel snug but not tight or loose.

Boots on the correct

- ■Wire is securely fixed?
- Is the clip closed and secure?

MP UP THE AIR CHAMBER





- Squeeze pump onto valve by pressing between your thumb and forefinger. If air is escaping there will be a hissing sound - just re-position the pump squarely onto the valve. Release the pump from the valve quickly so that no air escapes (a slight flick of the wrist may help).
- Check the inflated air chamber for firmness it should be firm with give and not hard.
